At Camp Jojo we pride ourselves on ensuring all activities are accessible to every family member: bushcraft activities, time round the fire and lots of outdoor fun, foraging, beach time, tomahawk throwing, feeding farm animals, campfires, tai chi, fire lighting, music, massage and much more.

Below is information on Rascal's soft play centre in Clacton as they will be running a weekly after school session for children with additional needs. It starts on the 4<sup>th</sup> November.

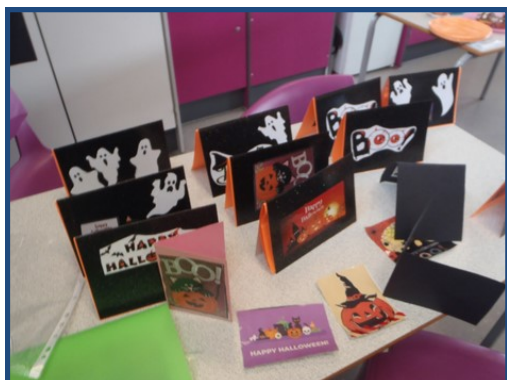
