1. Befriending Support service

Home-Start Colchester continues to provide an essential befriending Service to parents across Colchester and South Tendring currently via phone calls, emails and texts. If you are struggling and need someone to listen, to care and offer support, please contact Home-Start Colchester.



2. Getting essential items to families in need:

Home-Start Colchester successfully applied and secured small grants to benefit local families. We have created essential goods packs bespoke to each family's requests and needs.

5. Online parenting programs with co-ordinator support

6. Food— Distributing Foodbank vouchers and when needed we collect and deliver food to the family home.



Home-Start is working in partnership by distributing Foodbank vouchers to families. You can collect them at our offices at The Ark, Highwoods or The Mill Old Rd Clacton.

We are also able if needed to collect and deliver food to your family home. We can often combined this with our essential goods to help families manage through these difficult times.

7. Reducing Parental Conflict

Home-Start is able to provide advice and guidance to support families with many issues . We currently deliver the Reducing Parental Conflict Program in partnership with Tavistock Institute of Medical Psychology trading as Tavistock Relationships (Tavistock) .

10. Detached and Outreach Youth Work-10-14 years

Working with children aged 10-14yrs offering both detached youth work and outreach youth work in Greenstead and Jaywick. This work aims to help young people who are vulnerable because of the Coronavirus pandemic and provide them with access to a trusted adult and a safe activity and environment until they are reintegrated back into their traditional support structures and youth clubs .








11. Support Groups
