



POST 16-19 BURSARY

SHOREFIELDS SCHOOL

The 16 to 19 Bursary Fund exists to provide students at Shorefields financial support to access education. The intention of this bursary is to provide support to the most financially challenged students to remain in education. However, the allocation of money from the Government is finite, and consequently exact sums may vary dependant on the demands of these funds. The principles of fairness and supporting students in the greatest need will underpin all decisions taken.

Any Bursary support awarded to a student will always be conditional on attendance, behaviour and full compliance with the home/school agreement.

The Bursary fund is intended to help students overcome financial barriers to participation.

There are two types of 16 to 19 bursaries:

- The discretionary bursaries which schools award to overcome barriers to individual educational needs. For example, to help with the cost of transport, specific school and community activities.
- The vulnerable bursary for young people in one of the defined vulnerable groups, such as Looked After Children.
