The Local Authority have received notification that the SEND Local Area revisit will take place between Tuesday 17 May 2022 and Thursday 19 May 2022.

The letter attached, from the inspection team, explains the revisit and how you can share your views as a parent and/or carer. There are several ways to share your views — through an online survey, by email or via the Essex Family Forum.

The letter also mentions opportunities for children, young people and their parents and carers to speak to the Ofsted and CQC inspectors. As soon as we have more details about these sessions, we will share them on the Local Offer, through the Local Offer social media and through all the support groups for SEND families.
