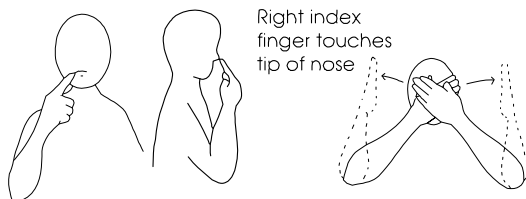

The sessions run from 9am-4pm weekdays and 9.30am-3.30pm on Saturdays.

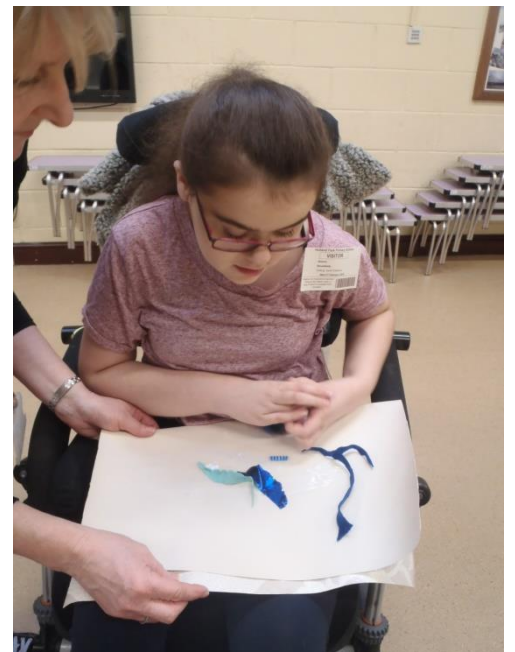
****UPDATE ON PINK DAY****
