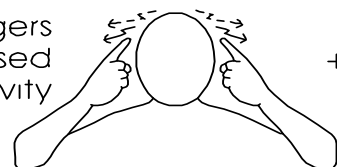
Polite notice if you are dropping off/picking up

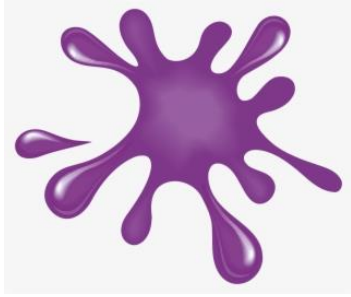
