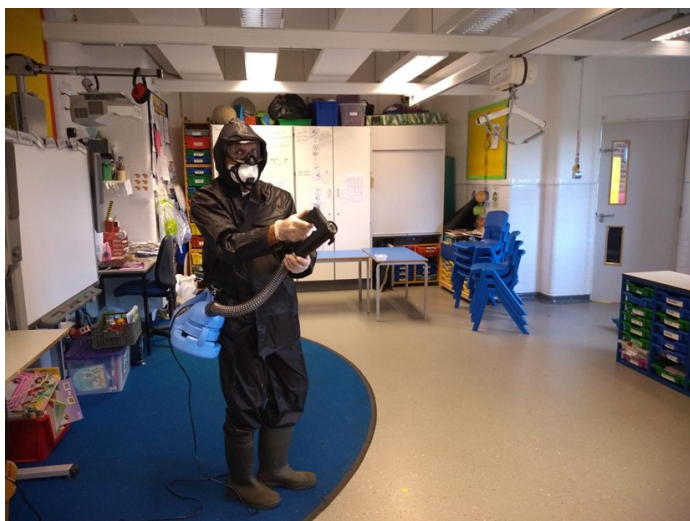

A few pictures below of Pete and James 'fogging' our class rooms and sensory rooms, just some of the extra hygiene steps we are taking in order to keep our children and staff safe.

Fogging uses an antiviral disinfectant solution which cleans and sanitises large areas of a building quickly and effectively. It can kill off the virus and other biological agents in the air and on surfaces. The task involves spraying a fine mist from a spray gun which is then left to evaporate, usually for 6 hours. The task requires the person to wear a chemical suit, gloves and an air fed ventilator and sealed mask etc. Once treated, the area must be sealed off completely for some time afterwards.

The product used is safe on equipment such as printers, computers etc. as the mist is exceptionally fine but effective in penetrating all areas to kill off the virus.
