Hydrotherapy Pool

We have had some questions raised about the reopening this week of the hydrotherapy pool, we initially had to close it last half term due to a mechanical failure which has now been fixed. Our comprehensive risk assessments that are in place adhere to all national and regulatory guidelines, and although public pools remain closed during this period of lockdown, as our hydro pool is classed as a clinical environment, guidelines now permit the pool to remain open.

As a school we are proud of high standards of hygiene and as such have taken extra precautions on top of our normal operating procedures. Students will only access the hydro pool currently if they have a recommendation by the local physio or its stated within their EHCP. Students will only swim in their class bubble and enhanced cleaning will take place, in addition to this the pool has a natural water chemistry turn over time and therefore the pool will be closed for an extended period over the lunch to allow for the turnover to be completed. We maintain our PH and chlorine and secondary UV disinfectant within set regulatory standards.

The growing evidence around COVID-19 from our regulatory body state that,

"With adequately disinfected pool water, the main risk from Covid-19 is through airborne respiratory transmission from a person carrying this virus to others within critical vicinity – not from waterborne transmission. The available evidence shows that the physical effect of the pool water and an appropriate relationship between free chlorine and pH value should inactivate the virus within 15-30 seconds. The dilution of virus in the pool water volume will also reduce the risk of exposure and transmission"
