Free School Meal Vouchers

As part of the Essex County Council COVID Winter Support Grant Scheme, the Free School Meals voucher scheme has been extended and will be available for the Easter holidays.

Free school meal vouchers are available to those in receipt of free school meals and PPG for those pupils in years R, 1 and 2 (Universal Infant Free School Meals available for pupils in years, R, 1 and 2 do not qualify for vouchers)

As before, the free school meal vouchers will be allocated via Wonde and for the Easter holidays this amount will be £30 per eligible pupil - we are able to order the vouchers next week

There are other funding and support options available as part of the COVID Winter Support Grant:

Essex Essential Living Fund

Households struggling to pay food, fuel or water bills and for other essential household goods such as fridges or cookers can apply for an emergency grant from Essex Essential Living Fund (EELF).

Anyone can apply but EELF will advise on eligibility and what they could get.
