Hello everyone, I, Sarah Williams have been working with lots of students on developing their individual communication skills, since joining the school team in February, as your Communication Lead. I have spent time working across Sunshine and Beach strands, now moving to Pier, getting to know these children and young people, and have already had many "WOW" moments. Although you all get to view so many of these celebrations on Tapestry, I also want to share a huge "Communication Celebration" to a pupil in Beach 2. Over the last few weeks, he has participated wonderfully in PECS and using his folder to request the types of play and activities that he's really motivated by, which currently is posting flashcards and small key items, into a cardboard post box.

We have been working on travelling with PECS and this was achieved last week. He has been able to continue to travel with his "I want" strip in class and has been so determined to get what he wants . He will load his "I want" strip, look for the adult, move out of the chair and walk towards the adult to get what he wants, then repeats numerous times. All the time, vocalising with sounds and continued joint attention developing. What a super star. Well done.
