Beach 1—one young man managed a trip to Asda, pushed the trolley and found all the listed items

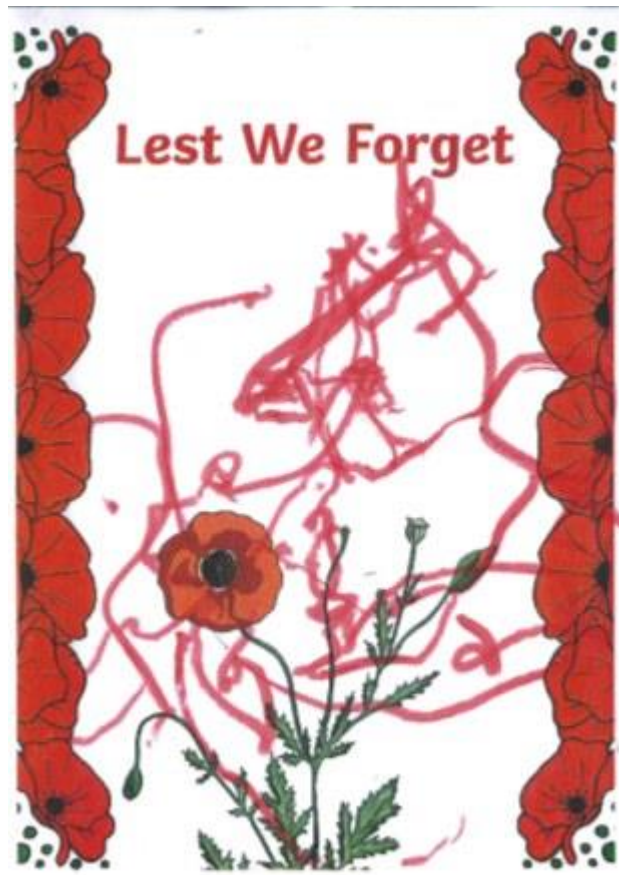
Beach 4—proud of all of Beach 4, lots of PECS use and spontaneous language
